FILM SOCIETY OF MINNEAPOLIS ST. PAUL UNVEILS 2016 CINE LATINO FILM FESTIVAL OPENING, SATURDAY NIGHT AND CLOSING PRESENTATIONS

September 21, 2016 Minneapolis, MN — The Film Society of Minneapolis St. Paul today announced the Opening, Saturday Night and Closing Presentations of their fourth annual [Cine Latino MSP Film Festival](#), **November 11-17, 2016**.

Cine Latino will open with the tender and funny Spanish/Argentine drama [Truman](#), winner of five Goya Awards including Best Film, Best Director, Best Original Screenplay, Best Actor, and Best Supporting Actor. Directed by Cesc Gay (*A Gun In Each Hand, Fiction*), *Truman* stars Ricardo Darín and Javier Cámara as longtime friends facing adversity. Screening Thursday, November 11 at 7:00pm at the St. Anthony Main Theatre, followed by the Opening Night Party.

The Saturday Night Special Presentation is [Neruda](#), directed by Chile's multi award-winning Pablo Larraín (*NO, Jackie*) Chile/Argentina. *Neruda* explores the vivid life of the seminal poet, senator and expert raconteur, Pablo Neruda, played by Luis Gnecco, through a cat-and-mouse tale with Gael Garcia Bernal in the role of his nemesis, the cunning special investigator, Oscar Bustamante Peluchonneau. Screening Saturday, November 12 at 7:00pm at the St. Anthony Main Theatre.

The festival will close with [The Tenth Man](#), by Daniel Burman (*Empty Nest, Lost Embrace*), a discerning Argentinian comedy that wrestles with the notions of identity, home and the complexities of father-son relationships. Winner, Best Actor, 2016 Tribeca Film Festival. Panorama Opening Night, 2016 Berlin Film Festival. Screening Thursday, November 17 at 7:00pm at the St. Anthony Main Theatre, followed by the Closing Night Party.
